



Conclusion

Bariatric and Metabolic surgery exist ten years in Serbia (and Montenegro).

There is no large number of operations, becouse government does not support metabolic operations (financial reason?).

Two larges cities in Serbia (Belgrade and Novi Sad) are centers of tertiary surgery as well as metabolic surgery, especially in hands of esophageal surgeons.

In three CME courses organized in Novi Sad (Sr. Kamenica) there was limited interes of surgeons for education in Bariatric and Metabolic surgery.

IFSO chapter in Serbia does not exist in real life.

We need organized support from Bariatric and Metaboloic Surgery community.
